

GETTY MULTICULTURAL UNDERGRADUATE SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM 2008

Stipend: \$3,500 for 10 weeks

The Chinese American Museum is offering two (2) paid, full-time summer internships for qualified undergraduate students from June 16- August 22, 2008.

One Curatorial/ Collections internship to catalog, organize, and research in support of our next permanent exhibit about Chinese American culture. The intern will also be assisting with preparing exhibition space for CAM's upcoming temporary exhibit.

One Education internship to develop curriculum about Chinese American history and immigration, assist in docent training, and help in developing public programs at the Museum.

Qualifications: These internships are available for currently enrolled full-time undergraduates. The internship opportunities are intended for members of groups underrepresented in the professions related to museum and visual arts: individuals of African American, Asian, Latino/Hispanic, Native American, and Pacific Islander descent. Intern candidates from all areas of undergraduate study are welcome and are not required to have demonstrated a previous commitment to museum studies or the visual arts. **Applicants must:**

- 1) **have completed at least one semester of college by June 2008;**
- 2) **not be graduating before December 2008;**
- 3) **be a resident of OR attend college in Los Angeles County; and**
- 4) **commit to completing 10 consecutive weeks of a full-time internship**

Duration: June 16- August 22, 2008 (10 weeks)

Hours per Week: 40 hours (8 hours each day)

Stipend: \$3,500 for a ten week period

Deadline: 5:00 PM on Friday, May 9, 2008
