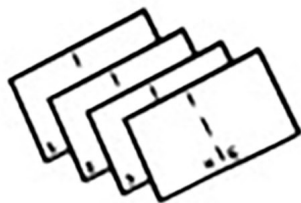


## HOW TO ASSEMBLE:

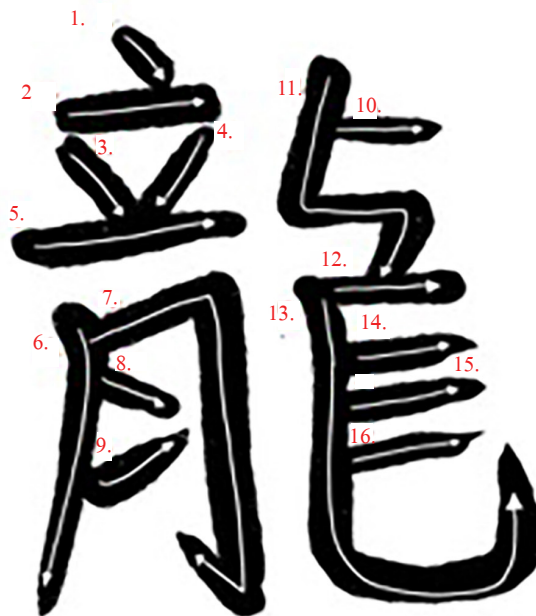

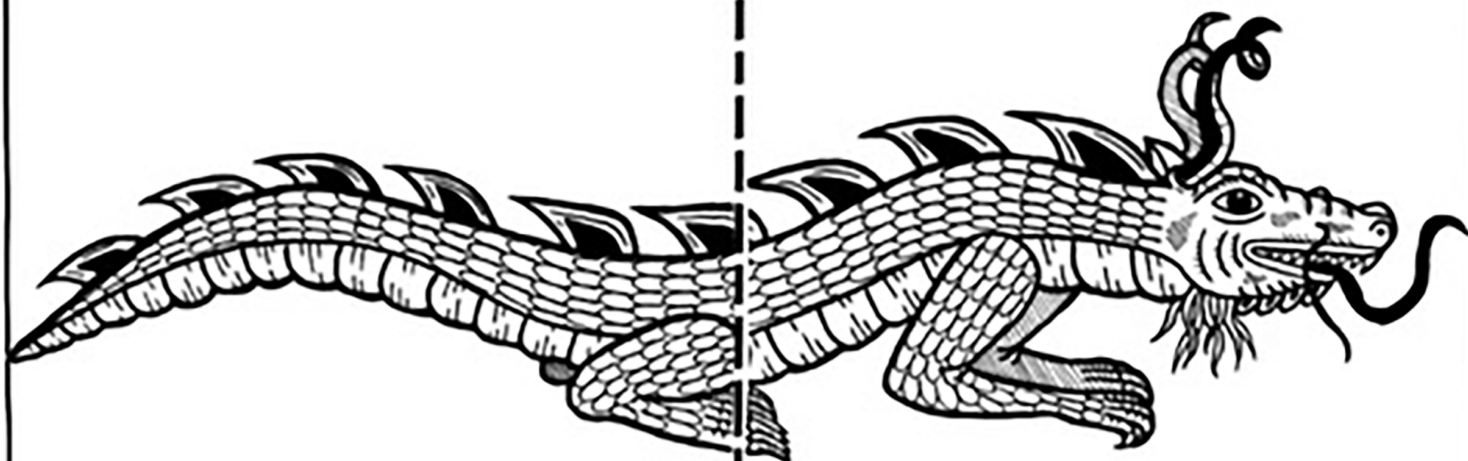
